Dear Titan Students and Parents,

We hope that this letter finds you doing well and enjoying your summer. In just under a month, we will be back in the swing of things and school will be in session. During the summer, many people have been working diligently to ensure that we are ready to welcome approximately 1,250 students through our doors when school starts on Tuesday, August 22nd. We look forward to welcoming you and all of your classmates back to school!

As we approach the start of school, we wanted to inform you of several important items, the first of which is Student Orientation. Orientation is an event where students will pick up their class listings (not a schedule, but a list of classes), receive their locker assignment and combination, have an opportunity to add money to their cafeteria account, and purchase PE uniforms for a cost of \$20.00 for a set of shorts and t-shirt. *Please note that students with any outstanding fees or fines from last school year, and/or any student who has an incomplete immunization record may not receive his/her class listing, locker, or textbooks until their records are cleared.* Parents are encouraged to attend with their children. Orientation is a come-and-go event; please come at any time during your child's scheduled orientation time (below). Please park in the parking lot on the East (bus ramp) side of the building, and enter through the doors near the bus ramp.

The schedule for Orientation is as follows:

- 6th Grade Wednesday, August 9th (9:00-Noon)
- 7th Grade Tuesday, August 8th (1:00-4:00)
- 8th Grade Tuesday, August 8th (9:00-Noon)

- 6th graders will report to the Commons (cafeteria)
- 7th graders will report to the Boys' Gym
- 8th graders will report to the Girls' Gym
