We are saddened by the senseless loss of life in Santa Fe on Friday morning. At Sugar Land MS we are committed to the safety and well-being of all of our students, staff, families, and visitors. We remain vigilant to ensure that everyone stays safe. The protocols we have in place, such as Let's Talk and Talk Line (281) 240-TALK, as well as an open-door policy for students to talk to administrators and counselors, among others, are there to ensure students' concerns are heard. As has been shared previously, it is important that students also play a role in their own safety by making adults aware of anything that concerns them. It is important for them to know that if they have concerns about their friends and classmates that they are encouraged to speak up. It is not an act of betrayal of their friends if they express concerns to adults. Rather, it is an act of love and care that may end up saving lives. This includes reporting any concerns related to social media postings. Counselors will be available Monday to talk to students who may experience anxiety over the events from Friday. The district has added some resources for parents and teachers related to coping with school violence to its Counseling and Postsecondary Readiness webpage. Know that we have your child's best interest at heart. Thank you for the support you provide to your children and to their school.
