Safety Reminders for Parents

Please note the following safety concerns that have recently been observed. The City of Sugar Land has been issuing citations in recent weeks for all of the items listed below:

- U-Turns are no longer permitted along Seventh Street; note new signage installed by the City of Sugar Land along Seventh Street west of the school and City Park
- Left turns from our circle drive are not permitted during morning arrival and afternoon dismissal
