We are a week into the second nine weeks (Term 2), and we hope that you and your family are doing well. Here are some items of general interest for all SLMS families, and one item regarding safety. We will start with the safety item.

Safety During Morning Arrival and Afternoon Dismissal

Student safety is our number one concern at SLMS, and to make sure students are safe at morning arrival and during dismissal, we want to remind parents of a few points that have increasingly become problematic.

Concern	Additional Information
Left turns out of the front circle drive during posted, prohibited times. Please observe signage which states that left turns are prohibited from 7:05-9:00 AM and 3:15- 3:45 PM.	
Dropping students off in the east parking lot by the bus ramp. Please observe signage which states that entrance is not permitted between 8:00-9:00 AM and 3:30-4:15 PM. Note that we are working to get the sign revised so that the afternoon hours extend to 4:30. Only drop children off in the front circle drive	BETWEEN 8:00 AM - 9:00 AM 3:30 PM - 4:15 PM
Making U-Turns on Seventh Street just west of campus. Please do not make U- Turns on Seventh Street. Signage was installed a few weeks ago by the City of Sugar Land, and SLPD is enforcing this.	
Dropping off/picking up students along Seventh Street. Please only drop off/pick up your children in the front circle drive.	There is a dedicated right-turn lane off Seventh Street, leading into the front circle drive. Crossing this solid white line may result in a ticket. SLPD has issued many tickets in the last year for this violation
