Ongoing Safety Concerns during Morning Arrival and Afternoon Dismissal

Student safety has been and always will be *our number one priority* at SLMS, and to underscore this point, we sent a reminder to parents in the last two editions of this newsletter regarding a few driver behaviors that have become increasingly problematic. We continue to observe drivers making left-hand turns out of our circle drive, which is clearly marked with a no-left turn sign. <u>Please click here to read that information</u>. Please help us keep all children safe, as well as avoid unnecessary traffic tickets for yourself, which are expensive in school zones.

Important Emergency Drill Information

This week we will conduct a Lockdown drill. This drill was scheduled to occur the week before Thanksgiving, but unforeseen circumstances prevented us from completing it. We have prepared the students and staff ahead of time with our expectations and instructions of what to do if a Lockdown occurs during a passing period or during lunch. We are alerting you now that we are doing this so that when we conduct it, you will know it is a drill. We want students to take it seriously, but we also do not want them to panic and start to call or text parents saying that something terrible is happening at school. Safety is our number one priority. Note, also, that FBISD Police will be on hand during this drill to observe and provide feedback to us so that we do the best possible job of keeping everyone out of harm's way. We will conduct another similar drill during the second semester, as well.

Semester Exam Information

Semester Exams are coming up in mid-December (just around the corner!). <u>The semester exam</u> <u>schedule is available on our campus webpage</u>. **Please note that no exams will be administered early**. Students who miss an exam in December will make it up during the first two weeks in January, once the school year resumes and we start the second semester.

Information Regarding Ingredients, Such as Pork, in Food Served in SLMS Cafeteria

Some students and families have asked questions about ingredients in food prepared in our cafeteria. The district realizes that many students, for a variety of reasons, cannot eat pork. Please note that according to the FBISD Child Nutrition Department's Dietitian, Linda Ankner, the only item that is served in FBISD middle school cafeterias that contains pork is the "sausage on a bun". All other meat-

based food is made of beef, chicken, or turkey, with no pork by-products. This includes when we do our sack lunches during the two early release days at the end of the semester when ham sandwiches are served—the ham is actually turkey, not pork. Here is a list of items served and what their actual content is:

- Pepperoni Pizza (turkey pepperoni)
- Breakfast Sausage Pizza (turkey sausage)
- Hot Dogs (beef hot dogs)
- Sausage Patties (chicken sausage)
- Ham Sandwiches (turkey ham)
- Meatloaf (ground beef)
- Sausage on a Bun (this is the **ONLY** pork product served in FBISD MS cafeterias)
