I ask that you use this incident to remind your child not to bring prohibited items to school. Also, please encourage your child to report any situation that makes them feel unsafe or uncomfortable to a trusted adult, teacher, or campus administrator.

Also, I realize we are a few days away from Spring Break and students may be getting a little restless, but learning is still taking place, and students should act accordingly. Please remind your children to continue to conduct themselves with SLMS Titan pride as we progress to Spring Break and through the remainder of the school year.

It takes all of us working together to make SLMS a safe and enjoyable learning environment for everyone, which is the philosophy embedded in our campus mission:
