We will complete the draft of our GWC Project WHS App specifics (to solve a problem on campus) from November 2021- January 2022.

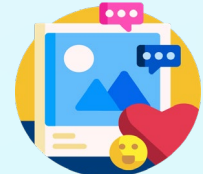
