"Will You Read to Me?"

Research shows that reading to young children just 20 minutes a day can make a significant difference in their overall reading level once they reach school age. How you read to children can also make a big difference!

- Snuggle up closely as you read so children will associate reading with a warm, loving feeling.
- Choose books with rhyming words and funny sounds...children love them!
- Select books with large, colorful pictures.
- Let your voice get soft and loud as you read; change the pace of your reading; use lots of expression.
- Encourage children to point to the pictures, repeat the words, turn the pages.
- Ask questions; encourage guessing.
- Let children fill in missing words.
- Reread old favorites again and again.
- Try to read to children whenever they come to you with a book.
- Take pleasure in your reading time together, and make sure they know how much you love it!



Bounce-Back Kids... Helping Children Overcome Adversity

As parents, we know that it is impossible to totally protect our children from setbacks and disappointments in life. All children are potentially vulnerable. For this reason we must help our children develop coping skills and resiliency factors so that they will be able to meet life's challenges and become stronger and wiser in the process.

Help your children become resilient by:

- being a caring and supportive adult in their lives
- spending meaningful time with them
- developing an open, safe level of communication
- using language that helps build a sense of optimism
- helping them develop a sense of humor
 teaching caring and compassion for others
- setting realistic expectations that encourage them to "stretch"
- gestablishing clear rules and consequences
- helping them view mistakes as an opportunity to learn
- involving them in decision making and problem solving
- giving them responsibilities for self, family and community
- self, family and community
 avoiding patterns of rescuing and making excuses

Remember, resilient kids need opportunities to experience and handle diversity. Mom and dad can be there to support and encourage, but kids need to learn to draw from their own inner strengths.

For this reason we must help our children develop coping skills and resiliency factors so that they will be able to meet life's challenges and become stronger and wiser in the process.

Help your children become resilient by:

- being a caring and supportive adult in their lives
- spending meaningful time with them
- developing an open, safe level of communication
- using language that helps build a sense of optimism
- helping them develop a sense of humor
 teaching caring and compassion for others
- setting realistic expectations that encourage them to "stretch"
- gestablishing clear rules and consequences
- helping them view mistakes as an opportunity to learn
- involving them in decision making and problem solving
- giving them responsibilities for self, family and community
- self, family and community
 avoiding patterns of rescuing and making excuses

Remember, resilient kids need opportunities to experience and handle diversity. Mom and dad can be there to support and encourage, but kids need to learn to draw from their own inner strengths.

Loving Learning: How to Motivate



EAGERNESS TO LEARN IS AN "INSIDE JOB" MADE UP OF EXCITEMENT, PERSEVERANCE, GUMPTION AND COURAGE, PARENTS CANENCOURAGE A LOVE NORLEARNING IN CHILDREN BY.

- Gharing their own excitement about reading, writing, music, history, etc,
- Reading stories together that honor the value of hard work, e.g., Laura Ingalls Wilder
- DISPLAYING SAYINGS LIKE "GENIUS IS 10%
 INSPIRATION AND 90% PERSPIRATION,"
- TEACHING CHILDREN TO DO MEANINGFUL TASKS LIKE MOWING THE LAWN, DOING LAUNDRY AND COOKING
- Using words of encouragement such as "I know how hard you worked on that and your efforts really paid off,"
- Supporting children's interests (even if they are not the same as the parent's)

Is Your Childs Phone Safe or a Safety Hazard?

Texting is a Privilege

Having a cell phone or digital device is a privilege which teens should earn. If a teenager abuses the privilege with inappropriate texting, parents have the right, even the responsibility, to take away his/her digital device for a period of time. Here are some suggested guidelines:

- On a school night, put the digital device away in parents' bedroom at bedtime. The student can get it back the next morning when he/she is ready to go to school.
- Digital devices cannot be used during home work time unless the use is needed for the school work
- Children may not text when a parent or other adult is talking to them. Conversation takes priority.
- Establish family No Digital Device times which everyone observes: meal times, worship time, family meeting times, etc.
- Let your children know you will be checking their text messages regularly for dangerous activities. You need to know everyone with whom they are exchanging text messages just as you know the friends with whom they go out.
- If a student's grades drop below acceptable levels, he/she loses the digital device privilege until the grades have recovered.
- Stress there must be NO texting while driving.
