Lawrence E. Elkins High School 2021-2022 Student Parking Expectations

The purpose of the following guidelines is to provide our students, staff, and community with a safe environment to drive to and from Lawrence E. Elkins High School each day. Each Lawrence E. Elkins High School student driver must abide by each parking expectation as well as any other Fort Bend ISD expectation.

The Fort Bend ISD police department and our Lawrence E. Elkins High School Parking Lot Attendant are responsible for enforcing procedures that provide a safe campus environment for our students. Their jurisdiction can and will extend to any school-sponsored events.

Student initials are required and acknowledges your understanding of each expectation.

_____ Students are ONLY allowed to park in their assigned parking spot between 6:00 a.m. to 3:10 p.m. daily.

- _____ Students are prohibited from parking in the following areas: the teacher or visitor parking lots, bus ramp area, or band area after 3:10 p.m. daily.
- _____ Students attempting to leave campus or caught off-campus without proper justification will be issued a parking citation and can lose their parking privileges.
- _____ All students riding in the vehicle, not just the driver, will earn the same consequence.

It will be the responsibility of the student and their family to arrange for alternate transportation during the discipline period.

- Fort Bend ISD bus transportation is provided for those eligible.
- ____ The student will be held personally responsible for all items in their vehicle.
- ______ Students are subject to a vehicle search if school officials have reason to believe that a vehicle may contain any element of criminal activity.
- _____ All student drivers must provide an active state-issued drivers' license and proof of insurance.
- _____ 2021-2022 Lawrence E. Elkins High School student-parking permits are nontransferable.
- If a student is no longer able to drive or transfers from EHS for any reason, their student parking permit must be turned into the EHS Registrar's Office.

_ Upon arriving at school, students must immediately vacate their vehicle, then the parking lot, and enter the school building.

• No sitting in cars or loitering in parking lot.

Lawrence E. Elkins High School 2021-2022 Student Parking Expectations

The following are examples of student parking lot infractions that can cause a student's 2021-2022 student parking privileges to be revoked.

Parking regulations include, but are not limited to:

- 10-MPH speed limit on campus at all times
- No parking in faculty, bus ramp area, and/or visitor areas of EHS.
- Vehicle remaining in the band area after 3:10 p.m.
- No parking without a valid 2021-2022 EHS student-parking permit
- No parking in more than one parking space
- No display of obscene, indecent or offensive language affixed to vehicle <a>[2] Includes music

Reasons for immediate parking revocation include but not limited to:

- Students are not allowed to copy, recreate, obtain or use another student's parking pass at any time.
- DAEP Placement during the 2021-2022 school year
- Parking privileges may be suspended or revoked as a result of Administrative issued discipline.
- Any type of driving deemed to be unsafe by FBISD Police, campus parking attendant, or campus administration.
- Excessive attendance concerns which include but not limited to:
 - Excessive tardies
 - Excessive absences
 - o Skipping
