Ordering and registration deadlines for the spring administrations will be **available in the fall**.

Districts and schools will be able to administer all three assessments on as many days of the testing window as needed. If your state requires you to administer SAT School Day, PSAT10 or PSAT 8/9, your state may determine your testing schedule.

## National Recognition Programs

Academic honor for students demonstrating high degrees of academic achievement as demonstrated by a GPA of 3.5+ and who scored in the top 10% on the PSAT or a 3 or higher on two or more AP Exams by their junior year.

Spring: Students are **invited** to apply for the recognition or may **self-nominate**. **Counselors are notified** of invitations sent to their students.

2

August: **Awards** are communicated in August to students and counselors.

3

Fall: Students are encouraged to list their award on their **college applications**. Many colleges have specific **programs** and **scholarships** for students who earned an award.





# What's Changing

## Calculators Are Allowed on the Entire Math Section

A graphing calculator will be built into the testing app or students can bring their own.

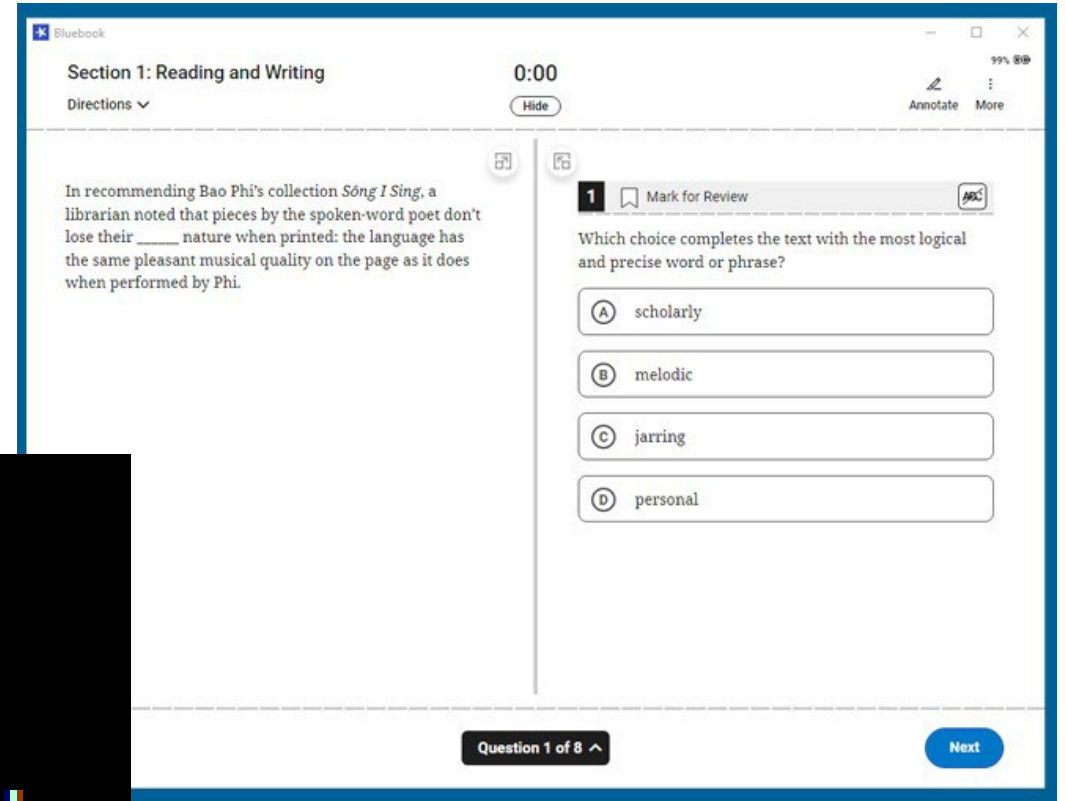

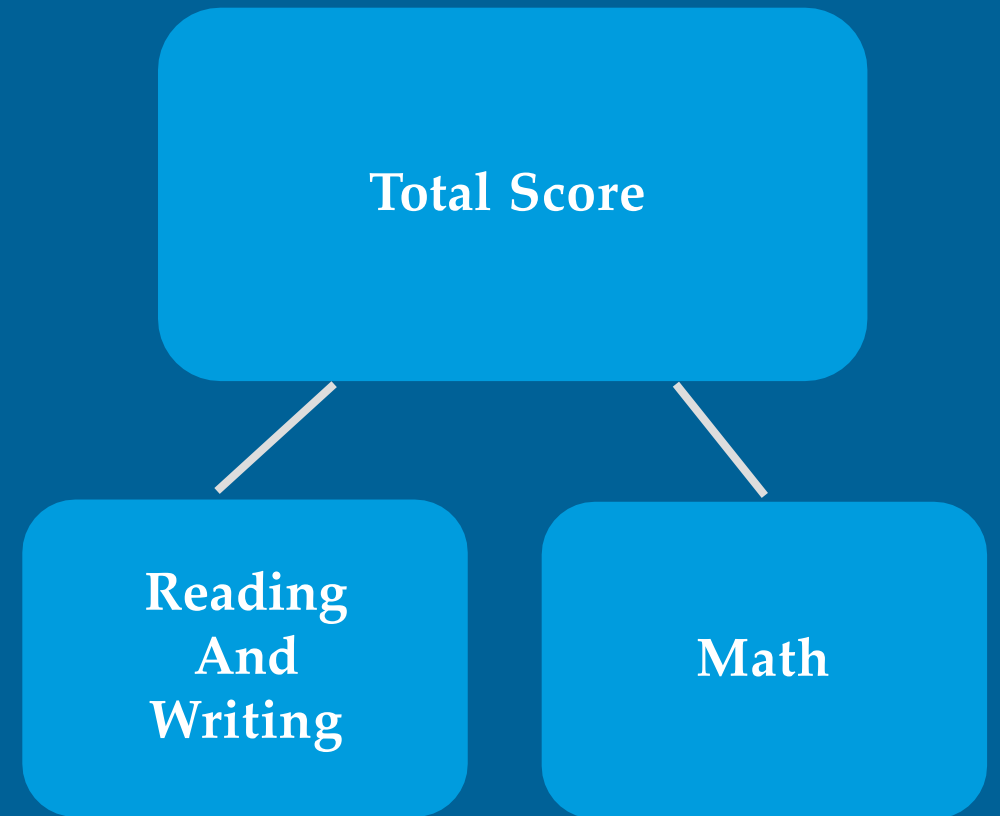

	Multi-Stage Adaptive Testing (MST)	Item Adaptive
<b>Test Delivery</b>	Sets of questions (called modules)	One item at a time
<b>Adaptive</b>	Based on how students perform in the previous module	Based on a student responds to each question
<b>Navigation</b>	Students can review items within a module	Students are not able to go back to a question
<b>Test Length</b>	Supports shorter test lengths	Supports shorter test lengths
<b>Examples</b>	GRE, digital SAT	ACCUPLACER, SBAC, NWEA – MAP, NCLEX

# Testing Staff Roles and Responsibilities

## Test Coordinator

- Oversees planning and test day activities for ALL students, including those with accommodations
- Works with technology staff to ensure devices being used for testing meet technical requirements and Bluebook is installed.
- Identifies staff to support test administration , ensures they have access to training and resources
- Submits Irregularity Report

## Technology Monitor\*

- New required role for digital testing
- Assists students and staff with technical troubleshooting in the help room on test day

## Proctor

- Starts and monitors the test using Test Day Toolkit
- Observes the room, helps students, keeps room free of distraction
- Complete printed seating chart
- Report irregularity in Test Day Toolkit

## Room/Hall Monitor

- Hall monitor: admits students using toolkit
- Monitors rooms and hallways; provides relief to proctors.
- Directs students to help room, break area, restroom

# Key Digital Administration Steps

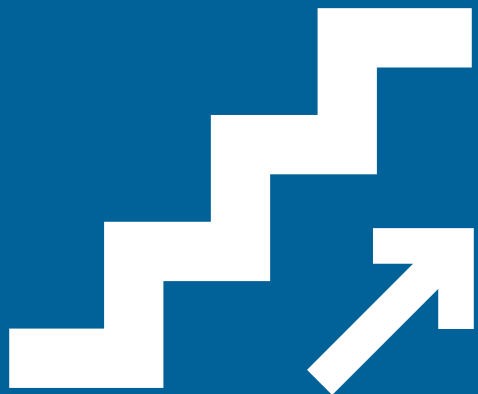
Action	Description	Timing
Ordering	Identify the assessments and grade levels you will be offering, when you plan to begin testing, and key staff	May - August
Registration	Submit a digital file of test taker information which will be used to deliver test packages and accommodations	September - October
Training	Complete training for test coordinators and other staff	September - October
Digital Readiness	Ensure Bluebook is installed properly, check devices, and complete exam set-up, etc.	September - October
Administration	Administer assessments based on your testing schedule	October
Scores/Reports	Share scores and reports with students and families	November



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## SAT Suite Ordering & Registration

- Access to SSOR will be provisioned using the Manage Access Tool.
- District ordering is available.
- Districts and school will be provided with an estimated cost when they place an order.
- Districts and schools will **NOT** be invoiced based on orders.



# Digital Readiness Check

## Purpose of the Digital Readiness Check:

- ✓ Ensure devices being used for testing meet technical requirements
- ✓ Ensure Bluebook is installed correctly
- ✓ Complete Exam Set-Up process
  - ✓ Review of test taker rules
  - ✓ Includes providing optional test taker information
  - ✓ Opt-in to BigFuture School and Connections
- ✓ Complete Test Preview
  - ✓ Explore universal tools
  - ✓ Answer sample questions

# Testing Policy Updates: Start Times & Devices

## Testing Start Times

- Testing may begin at any time during the school day however, it be completed by the end of the regular school day.
- Testing cannot be paused for standard test takers, so testing should occur before or after lunch.
- Staggering start times can help alleviate congestion in the hallway or restrooms.

## Devices

- May be used by more than one student for testing.
- Ensure devices can be charged if being used more than once on the same school day.
- If your district does not allow apps to auto-update, have a plan to ensure the Bluebook application is updated prior to testing.

# Testing Policy Updates: Testing Rooms & Assignments

## Testing Rooms

- Each testing room must have a wall clock that is easily visible to all students.
- Spacing and desk requirements remain the same.
- Computer labs may be used.
- Auditoriums with theatre style seating may be used.

## Room Assignments

- Testing staff will be assigned to rooms by the test coordinator in Test Day Toolkit.
- Students are not required to be pre-assigned to a testing room, but assignments are recommended.
- Students should be assigned to test rooms based on assessment, testing time, and other accommodations.
- Students that are re-testing should be assigned to a separate room.

# **Next Steps for District and Schools**

# Order Tests

- **Ensure coordinators at the district and campus level have access to the SAT Suite Ordering and Registration (SSOR) system.**
- **Orders can be placed at the district and/or campus level.**
  - If the district wants to pay for exams, the order must be placed at the district level.
  - Any tests ordered by the school will be invoiced to the school.
- **If a district needs a contract, the person placing the order will be able to indicate the need for a contract at the end of the ordering process.**

# Develop a Plan For Accommodations

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**College Board must approve all accommodations  
for PSAT 8/9, PSAT/NMSQT and SAT.**

- Ensure student IEP/504 plans reflect the accommodations needed to support digital testing.
- Develop a plan for submitting accommodations in time for fall testing.
- Review accommodations that have already been approved in case changes are needed.

# Check Your Device Inventory

- **Compare your devices to the technical specifications at [www.bluebook.collegeboard.org/technology](http://www.bluebook.collegeboard.org/technology).**
- **Approved devices include:**
  - 1:1 or shared school-managed devices or personal devices.
  - Personal or school-managed Mac and Windows laptops and desktops, iPads, and Windows tablets.
  - School-managed Chromebooks.
- **Decide if you'll allow students to bring their own personal devices for testing.**

# Check Network Readiness

- **Students need to be connected to the internet to start testing and to submit their answers at the end.**
  - If the internet disconnects during testing, students will be able to process through the test without disruption.
- **Test your network speed**
- **Choose testing rooms with good Wi-Fi.**
- **Make sure students and staff can access the network.**
  - If students will be testing on personal devices, have a plan in place to ensure those students can connect to Wi-Fi.

# Install the Bluebook App

- Visit [bluebook.collegeboard.org/technology](https://bluebook.collegeboard.org/technology) for instructions to install the latest version.
- Uninstall previous versions of the app
- Test the installation by opening the app on a student device.
- Check for app updates throughout the year.
- If you're planning to use Chromebooks, make sure that you have configured your Chromebooks to "Do Not Erase Local Data."
