



Meetings

Meetings will take place on the last Tuesday of every month (unless there is a scheduled holiday)

Meetings will be at least 30 minutes, and may last longer depending what needs to get done

Meetings are for sharing important information and collecting the finished goods

Attendance will be recorded every meeting

Members are recommended to miss no more than 2 meetings a semester. If

you cannot make a meeting, contact an officer via email or text on Remind. Tell them your Name, Grade, and reason for absence

Members will be reminded of dates and necessary supplies to bring prior to the meeting


