Calculator Release Statement

If the option of providing a calculator isn't feasible, or if a student doesn't want to use a calculator, they can take an exam without one. However, if a student chooses to take an exam without a calculator, they must hand copy, date, and sign the Calculator Release Statement (at right) and indicate the name of the exam being taken. Return the release statement in the exam shipment. (See pages 93–94.) I will not use the absence of a calculator as a reason to challenge my score on this exam.
