




Your Family Might Be Missing Out Academically!

School starts at 8:05 a.m.

Arriving to school late and leaving early could set your child at an academic disadvantage.

- Just 20 Minutes could lead to your child being behind in any of the core subjects.
- 30 Minutes late or early could lead to your child missing certain learning TEKS (this may be a Science or Social Studies lesson). Leading Too...
 - Lack of academic motivation
 - Issues retaining information from previously lessons
 - Disrupting the learning process
 - Poor Academic Performance

The habits you build with your student now will help your child in intermediate school, high school, and later in their career.

How Can You help?

- Set up a good night routine.
 - Set out clothes for the next day.
 - Read before bed and limit screen time.
 - Utilize rewards for following the bedtime weekly or monthly.
- Have an “Exit” plan and try to stick to it every morning.
- Refrain from picking up your child early from school unless absolutely necessary.





Hang Out with Your Kids!



One of the best ways to really get to know your child and understand his world is to "hang out together"! Children are not always good at telling mom or dad what their stresses and worries are. You can get in touch with your child's needs and at the same time, nurture your relationship by:

- ◊ just hanging out together...doing something you mutually enjoy
- ◊ letting your child choose how to spend this special time together
- ◊ excluding everyone else...this is YOUR time!
- ◊ getting away from it all...the TV, telephone, interruptions
- ◊ sometimes choosing a private spot (fishing beside a quiet creek, picnic in the woods, etc.)
- ◊ allowing for "quiet" time when there isn't any conversation; kids often need time to work up the nerve to tell parents something important
- ◊ developing a hobby or special interest that belongs just to the two of you



- ◊ laughing, being silly
- ◊ letting your child know how special it is when just the two of you are together!
