A note from the School Clinic

It is that time of the year again, Spring. South East Texas is always beautiful this time of year, except for the high tree & grass pollen count. Many children are having different symptoms of allergies and asthma. I have researched other local FBISD Elementary schools to determine what is the positive proactive plan of action that is done in relation to “allergies and recess.”

Many schools require a documented medical excuse note from a physician that specifies they must not be allowed in the outside air. If the physician’s note limits play, which is most of the time sufficient for allergy management, they will sit somewhere outside as designated by the grade level providing the supervision. Madden will follow a doctor’s recommendation note and we will take each student’s case by case. Playing outdoors at recess is counted as part of the time children must have by the state of Texas for daily physical activity.

## **UPDATE: 2018 - 2019 Madden Enrollment**

Due to high enrollment and always embracing safety of our children, Fort Bend ISD will continue to cap Madden Elementary for first through fifth grade students in the school year 2018-2019. (Tentatively, Madden Elementary has the potential to be capped until the New Elementary School is opened in the Aliana subdivision in 2020.)



Dear Parent:

Fort Bend Independent School District and Madden Elementary are sharing this information about the district and your child's campus with you as part of its obligations under the federal No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (NCLB).

Information on these report cards includes:

**Part I: Percent Tested and Student Achievement by Proficiency Level** – Provides the State of Texas Assessment of Academic Readiness (STAAR) performance results and participation for each subject area and grade level tested. Participation reports also include reports of the participation of Children with Individualized Education Plans (IEPs) by assessment type.

**Part II: Student Achievement and State Academic Annual Measurable Objectives (AMOs)** – Provides the AMO outcomes and data table of STAAR performance results for each subject area tested in the accountability subset. This section also includes participation rates on STAAR for reading/English and mathematics, use of alternative assessments, plus four-year and five-year graduation rates.

**Part III: Priority and Focus Schools** – Priority schools are the lowest 5% of Title I served campuses based on performance in reading and mathematics and graduation rates. Focus schools are 10% of Title I served campuses, not already identified as priority schools, that have the widest gaps between student group performance and safeguard targets.

**Part IV: Teacher Quality Data** – Provides information on teacher quality in three parts.

*Part A – Percent of Teachers by Highest Degree Held* – Professional qualifications of all public elementary and secondary teachers in the Texas.

*Part B and C – Teachers with Emergency/Provisional Credentials, Highly Qualified (HQ) Teachers Low Poverty/Low Poverty Summary Reports* – Percentage of all public elementary and secondary school teachers teaching with emergency or provisional credentials, and the percentage of classes in the state not taught by highly qualified teachers disaggregated by high-poverty compared to low-poverty schools.

**Part V: Graduates Enrolled in Texas Institution of Higher Education (IHE)** – Provides the percentage of students who enroll and begin instruction at an institution of higher education in Texas during the school year (fall or spring semester) following high school graduation.

**Part VI: Statewide National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) Results** – Provides most recent NAEP results for Texas showing reading and mathematics performance results and participation rates, disaggregated by student group. If you have difficulty accessing the information from the website, hard copies of the reports are available at the district or campus office.
