

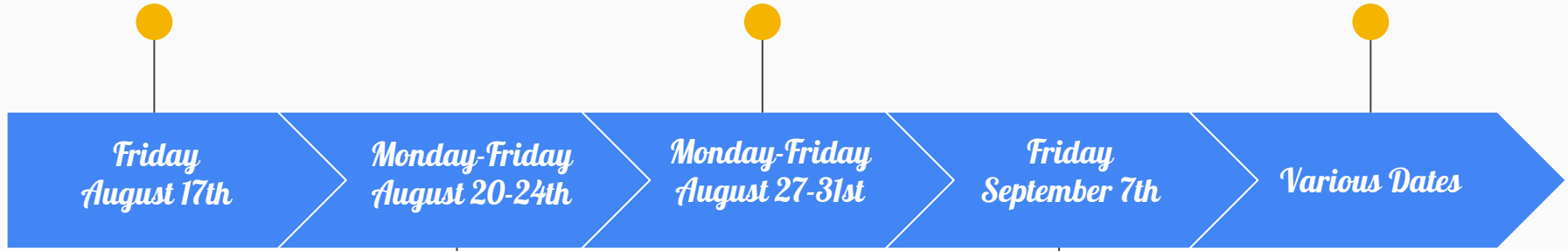
Madden Clubs

Students will receive a Club Ticket with the clubs available for their grade level listed.

Students must return their 1st choice club application to the club table and will receive a receipt.

Clubs will begin at various starting dates depending on sponsor. Dates will be listed on individual club applications.



Students must turn in their Club Ticket with parent signature at club table in exchange for their 1st choice club application.

Students will receive a letter accepting them or denying them into their 1st choice club. *If a 2nd choice option is available they will be placed into their 2nd choice.

General Information & FAQs

- *Clubs are only available for 2nd-5th grades*
- *All Clubs meet on either Tuesdays or Thursdays and release at either 4:30pm or 5:00pm (Dance is an exception, it will meet on Mondays)*
- *All clubs will have a \$10 per student fee to assist with materials for the club sponsor.*
- *Clubs will not interfere with NEHS or StuCo meetings which will be held on Wednesdays.*
- *Choir will no longer be considered a club, but will be available on Mondays to all 4th & 5th grade students who wish to participate and return the paperwork to Mrs. Wilson and Ms. Childers.*
- *We try to accommodate as many children into their first choice clubs before placing in a second choice club.*
- *STUDENTS are responsible for completing their applications and turning in their own tickets and applications to Mrs. Jackson on time. No late tickets or applications will be accepted.*
