Graduates

- Report to Clements HS Commons and <u>be seated by</u> 10:30AM.
- > Graduates should enter through the doors near the library.
- > Graduates will receive wrist bands that must be worn.
- Students MUST ride buses to Smart Financial Centre (SFC)
- ➤ Graduates **MAY NOT** be dropped off at the SFC.
- Graduates WILL exit the SFC and be released to their parent(s)/guardian(s) at the conclusion of the ceremony.
- > Student bus transportation to Clements will **not** be provided.

Parents

- > Tickets will be distributed to students on May 29 at the mandatory 9:35 AM graduation meeting at CHS.
- > Tickets will be required to enter the SFC for every guest two (2) years old and above.
- > Upon arrival no students will be allowed to leave the bus area or backstage at SFC.
- > There will be no reserved seating in the general seating area. Strollers are not allowed in the seating sections.
- > After graduation, you will meet your graduate outside SFC to take photos.
- Graduates will depart from Smart Financial Centre with families/friends.

Security

- Arriving 30 minutes (no earlier) before their student's graduation will reduce the long wait in the heat.
- > Each guest entering the Smart Financial Centre will have to pass through metal detectors.
- ➤ All handbags, purses, etc., are subject to search.
- No outside food or drinks are allowed. Bottled water will be for sale at the event.
- Balloons, air horns/noisemakers, big head cut outs, banners/flags and confetti are not allowed. Other prohibited items include, but are not limited to, weapons, tripods, monopods or selfie sticks and laptops/electronic tablets.

Diplomas

- > Students receive a diploma cover at the graduation ceremony. Diplomas will be ready for pick-up at CHS beginning June 25, 2018. All fees/fines must be cleared. Only the graduate or parent may pick up the diploma and must have a valid ID.
- > CHS Summer Hours: Monday through Thursday, 8 - 11AM and 1 - 5 PM.

Graduate Dress Code

- No shorts, tennis shoes, flip flops, thong sandals, or sunglasses.
- Arrive at CHS dressed in your cap and gown.
- > Do NOT attach any extra items to your cap. No Bling!
- > Do NOT bring cameras, purses, backpacks, etc.
- > Do NOT leave any items on the bus.
- You will not be allowed to take anything onto the stage; therefore, leave all personal belongings at home or with your parent(s)/guardian(s)/family.

MALE - Dress Code

- > Slacks, shirt with collar, tie, dark shoes, dark socks
- You must be clean shaven.

FEMALE - Dress Code

Skirt, slacks and blouse or dress, with dark shoes look best, for your safety avoid excessively HIGH heels.

Parking Parents & Guests

- ➤ Parents and guests may park in the parking area next to SFC. Onsite paid parking will be available the day of the event for \$10.00 per vehicle.
- ➤ In order to expedite parking on the day of graduation, Smart Financial Centre set up an online ticket system where parents can pre-purchase a parking pass. To pre-purchase parking passes: https://www.fortbendisd.com/Page/97073
- > Handicapped parking is available on the north side of the building. Inside the building, there are special areas set aside for wheel chairs and other mobility-impaired persons. SFC personnel will assist with the directions.

Reminders for Graduates

- > Graduates will be assigned to a row, seat and bus.
- Graduates must wear wristbands on the bus to be admitted to SFC.
- All graduates will ride the bus to the SFC.
- > Each student will go through a metal detector prior to entering SFC. Have your phone/keys in your hands.
- > During diploma distribution, graduates must remain seated until your row is directed to stand. After you cross the stage, move your tassel to the left.
- A professional photographer will be on the stage taking formal pictures.
- At the end of the ceremony, you **MUST** exit the building.
- Graduates will meet their families/friends on the north side of the SFC.
