


How to find my child's STAAR scores?

- Go to www.texasassessment.com
- Click on “Log In to Student Portal” within the Purple Box



- Enter your access code and student date of birth and click GO. Your access code can be found at the bottom of any STAAR Confidential Student Report you have ever received.

- If you do not know your access code, click on “Lookup Access Code.”


