KHS STAAR EOC SUMMER RETEST INFORMATION

All Summer STAAR EOC testing will take place at Fort Settlement MS (5440 Elkins Rd. Sugar Land, TX 77479) the week of June 23.

The STAAR EOC retest schedule is as follows:

- Monday, June 23-English I
- Tuesday, June 24-Biology and U.S. History
- Wednesday, June 25-English II
- Thursday, June 26-Algebra

Please refer to email that was sent to both parent and student (at FBISD email address) on May 27 (and June 4 if not yet registered) stating which EOC exam(s) needs to be retaken. If you did not register by the June 8 deadline, but would like to still test, please contact Summer Testing Coordinator, Michelle Miller (marym.miller@fortbendisd.gov).

A Schoology tutorial course is available to help students prepare for the summer testing. Your student may work on these online tutorials from home or any place with internet access 24 hours a day. Please go to Schoology and access the course using access code **3DZ2-ZZMS-W92QF**.

Students Driving or Being Dropped Off

- The summer testing coordinator will communicate regarding where to park if student is driving themself, or where to drop off and pick up.
- Make sure your student has a phone to communicate with their ride once they are done testing (or they can use FSMS front office phone). They will turn it in while testing.

Bus Transportation from Kempner HS to FSMS (ROUTE 2128):

If your student will need bus transportation, the bus will pick up students at Kempner HS each day of testing and return them to Kempner HS. **Students are responsible for transportation to and from KHS.**

Pick up from KHS:

- **7:10am** (Have student at KHS by <mark>7:05am</mark>). Make sure your student is on time.
- BUS RAMP NEXT TO NORTHERNMOST SIDE SCHOOL ENTRANCE DOORS BY 600s ART CLASSROOMS ACROSS FROM T-SHACKS.

- Student can be dropped off at front circle drive or the back student parking lot and the student can then walk to the bus ramp from there. Students are not able to enter Kempner HS. Report directly to bus pick up site.
- If your student is normally attending summer school and needing bus transportation to FSMS for testing, then they do not go to summer school the day of your test(s). They need to come straight to Kempner by 7:05am to catch the bus to FSMS.

Return time to KHS:

- If finished testing by 10:30am: bus will return to KHS at 11:10am
- If finished testing after 10:30am: bus will return to KHS at 12:40pm
- Make sure your student brings a phone so they can communicate with their ride picking them up at KHS. They will turn it in while testing.

General Information

Lunch will not be provided, although one can be brought by the student. It is highly recommended that students have a ride home available with a family member or friend once testing is complete so they do not possibly have to wait for an extended amount of time.

Students will need to arrive at FSMS and be in their testing room no later than 7:30am on their test day and are required to know their ID number in order to enter the testing room. Make sure to bring their charged laptop and charging cord! Remember, electronic devices of any kind (i.e. cell phones, air pods, etc.) are not allowed during testing and must be turned in. Students may bring bottled water and a snack if they would like. A light jacket is also recommended.

Students who drive or are being picked up will be dismissed from their testing room upon completion of their test and must immediately exit the building.

Summer School Info

Students who are attending Summer School will receive an excused absence from Summer School to attend STAAR EOC Testing. Let your teacher know in advance that you will be missing due to EOC testing so you can get your makeup work. The summer school principal will receive attendance of those who attended summer testing each day.

If not able to attend Summer Testing in June (i.e. out of town, on vacation, working), then the next opportunity to retest will be in December during school hours.
