## **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### **Students**

### What is the Application Committee looking for in an Academy student?

The Application Committee will consider the following information:

- Semester grades from courses taken in 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade
- STAAR Scores from 7th & 8th grade
  - If you do not attend a FBISD middle school, but live in the FBISD attendance zone, you will be required to upload standardized test scores to your application. Examples of acceptable test scores: PSAT, SAT, IOWA, Stanford, TerraNova, PASS, etc.
- Math Entrance Exam score

### What are the requirements to stay in the academy after I'm accepted?

Students must:

- Complete four Engineering courses as determined by the Engineering Pathway.
- Stay enrolled in a PreAP, AP, Honors, or Dual Credit math and science course all four years at Elkins.
- Complete computer science Pre-AP or higher.
- Participate in four pre-approved enrichment activities each academic year and complete 100 hours of community service.
- Complete the Engineering Capstone class.
- Maintain a 75 or above in all academy classes and a 70 or above in all non-academy classes.

#### What is the capstone course?

The capstone course is one of the four courses in the Engineering Pathway, and is taken during the senior year as a culmination of all your studies. Students will be responsible for the design and construction of a product of their choosing and will present their findings at the end of the year.

#### Is transportation provided?

At this time the District picks up/drops off non-zoned Academy students at their zoned elementary campus.

### Will there be transportation provided for afterschool activities?

No, all students must have their own transportation if staying afterschool for an extra-curricular activity.

### What kind of jobs can I obtain with the skills I have mastered in the Academy?

#### What is an enrichment activity?

A pre-approved activity that is in addition to your course work that pertains to math, science, or engineering. Some examples are listed here:

- Attend academy student meetings
- Attend Math and Science Honor Society meetings
- Attend the Technology Student Association meetings
- Attend an engineering academy field trip
- Attend a math, science, or engineering camp.

If you want to attend an event and want it to count as an enrichment activity, you will need to get prior approval from the academy coordinator.

#### How can I reach the 100 hours of community service goal?

Hours are broken down to a minimum of 25 service hours per academic year. The Engineering Academy partners with EHS YES to track hours. YES and the Engineering Academy provides volunteering opportunities throughout the year and during the summer.
