PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS / EXPECTATIONS

- Complete business/marketing credits in a coherent sequence as identified by the International Business & Marketing Pathway, and complete all appropriate course certifications.
- Earn a minimum of four credits in qualifying Pre-AP, AP, Honors, or Dual Credit coursework credits from ELA, math, social studies, fine arts or LOTE.
- · Complete AP or Dual Credit in Macro-Economics.
- Complete 100 hours of community service (25 a year) while enrolled in the academy.
- Maintain a 75 or higher in all academy specific courses, and a 70 or higher in all other courses.
- Participate in at least one academy activity per grading period.
- · Complete a graduation project.

APPLICATION AND COHORT INFORMATION

- Application to the International Business and Marketing Academy is open to all Fort Bend ISD 8th graders each year and occurs online.
 - Application review includes results of an interview, 7th grade STAAR scores, and a review of students' 7th and 8th grade semester grades in math, science, ELA and social studies.
 - Final acceptance is contingent upon successful completion of all 8th grade courses during the regular school year and all parts of the 8th grade STAAR exam.
- Students accepted into the International Business and Marketing Academy will attend high school at Travis High School, with other students in the cohort. Students will be a part of the THS student body and will be eligible for all other extracurricular activities, fine arts and athletic activities offered at the host campus.

- Students must reside in the FBISD attendance zone at the time of application.
- Students must have successfully passed all parts of the 7th grade STAAR exam.
- Students applying to the Digital Media, Global Studies, and International Business and Marketing academies will complete an interview.
- Students applying to the Math & Science, Engineering, and Medical Science academies will take an entrance exam.
- Notification of the date and time of the interview and/or entrance exam will be sent to the email address provided on the application.
