PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS / EXPECTATIONS

- Complete at least 11 credits through a combination of math and science courses (can be five math/six science or six math/five science) inclusive of Calculus AB or BC.
- Must take Pre-AP, AP, Honors or Dual Credit math and science courses all four years.
- Complete 100 hours of community service (25 a year) while enrolled in the academy.
- Maintain a 75 or higher in all academy-specific courses, and a 70 or higher in all other courses.
- Participate in at least one academy activity per grading period.
- Must complete a graduation project as outlined by the academy coordinator.

APPLICATION AND COHORT INFORMATION

- Application to the Math and Science Academy is open to all Fort Bend ISD 8th graders each year and occurs online.
 - Application review includes results of a math exam, 7th grade STAAR scores, and a review of students' 7th and 8th grade semester grades in math, science, ELA and social studies.
 - Final acceptance is contingent upon successful completion of all 8th grade courses during the regular school year and all parts of the 8th grade STAAR exam.
- Students accepted into the Math and Science Academy will attend high school at Dulles High School, with other students in the cohort. Students will be a part of the DHS student body and will be eligible for all other extracurricular activities, fine arts and athletic activities offered at the host campus.
