



Applicant Requirements

- Success on all sections of the 7th grade STAAR
- Currently resides in FBISD Attendance zone
- Currently in the 8th Grade

Academy Selection Criteria

- 7th grade semester grades in Math, Science, SS, ELA
- 8th grade semester grades in Math, Science, SS, ELA
- Academy entrance exam grade or Interview score

Step 3: Sit for the Exam/Interview – January

Step 4: Get Notified

Priority 1 Notifications – Feb. 10th

Regular Window Notifications – Feb. 18th

Waitlist Notifications – Feb. 25th

Step 5: Commit

Step 6: Attend Commitment Night – March 19th

 - First question will be sent via email

- Successful completion of all parts of the 8th Grade STAAR exam
