Schedule Changes

Level Down Courses: No level downs until the 6-week progress report period. Must talk to teacher and attend tutorials. More info later



COUNSELOR CORNER

- Grades are calculated on a semester basis.
- At the end of semester 1, students can earn .5 of a full year course if you receive a grade of 70 or higher. You can also earn .5 of semester 2 with a grade of 70 or higher.
- If a student fails a semester, the full credit can still be earned by averaging the 2 semesters.
- EXAMPLE: Semester I 67
 - Semester II 73
 - 67+73 = 140/2
 - Average = 70


All students will report to class on time.


Students are not permitted to leave class during the FIRST or LAST




AHS follows the FBISD Dress Code as found in the Student Code of Conduct




SAFETY IS #1 GOAL
