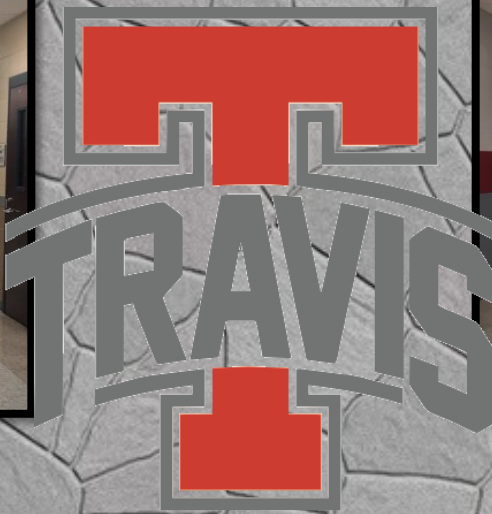
Now it's time to get some REST - because they are already talking about the next project they want to do!!
