Frequently Asked Questions
Application Process

- Q: How do I apply?
- A: Current FBISD students should follow the link found on the James Reese Career and Technical Center webpage to the application. They will use their student credentials to log-in and complete the application.
- Q: What do I do if I need to make changes to my application after I submit it?
- A: Please direct all change requests to <u>Kelley.Kirila@fortbendisd.com</u> and <u>Kenny.Kendziora@fortbendisd.com</u>.
- Q: What programs are available for students currently in 9<sup>th</sup> grade?
- A: Current 9<sup>th</sup> grade students are eligible for Information Technology, Arts, A/V Technology and Communications, and Automotive Mechanics (but not Diesel Mechanics).
- Q: Why can't I select Health Science?
- A: Only current 11<sup>th</sup> grade students are eligible to apply for Health Science. The course offered next year is for Seniors only.
- Q: Why can't I select Cosmetology?
- A: Only current 10<sup>th</sup> grade students are eligible to apply for Cosmetology.
- Q: I am a current Tech Ed student; do I have to complete an on-line application for next year?
- A: Current Tech Ed students only need to complete a new application if they want to switch programs. Current students remaining in their same program do not need to complete an online application.
- Q: If I select one form of transportation during the application process, can I change it throughout the year?
- A: Yes, students will have the opportunity to change their transportation decision during the commitment process.
- Q: My son/daughter is currently listed as a freshman but will have enough credits to be identified as a junior by the end of the year. How can he/she apply for programs that are open for current sophomore applicants only?

- Q: Can a student enroll in two programs at Reese Center?
- A: At this time, it is not possible to enroll in two programs simultaneously.
- Q: My student is in an Academy; can they take classes at Reese Center?
- A: Students in an Academy should work directly with their Academy Coordinator to review Academy requirements for their specific cohort.
- Q: When does the application close?
- A: The priority application window will close at 10:00 pm on February 5.
