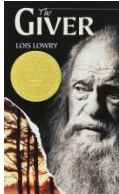


Dulles Middle School 2017 Summer Reading List

****Pre-AP Required: You must read this novel****

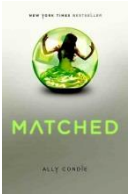
