# What Do I Need and Where Do I Go on the First Day of School?

## What to bring with you on Day 1 (Not a lot):

- String bag (no need for backpack today, really, but you can bring one; no rolling backpacks)
- Pen and Pencil
- Lunch (if not getting one from the lunch line)

## Where to Report and What to Do:

**Car Riders/ Walkers**: Enter the building through the front door. Parents- if your child is a car rider in the morning but a bus rider in the afternoon, please ensure that your child knows his/her route number so we do not have confusion at dismissal.

Bus Rider/Bike Riders: Enter through the bus ramp doors where you park your bike or walk off the bus.

**All Students**: once you arrive at the location above, look on the walls for listings (alphabetical by student last name), showing each student who their first period teacher is. When you find your name on the list, see who your first period teacher is and take note of their room number. Then, when dismissed you may head to that room.

Parents: Please DO NOT escort your child into the building. Please let them get out of the car or off the bus and walk into the school on their own. We do not have enough parking space to accommodate parents even at the entrances. We promise to take great care of your children!

**Transportation**- Please expect delays the first few days in the car rider line, with walkers, bikes riders and buses. It will take patience and time to work through the beginning of the year transportation. Based on past feedback, we continue to review the transportation systems set in place to ensure we

have the most efficient dismissal possible. Please note that the layout of our facility poses inherent challenges, and student safety remains our priority.

- 4. Complete or renew your application for Free or Reduced Meal Program by <u>visiting the Free and Reduced Meal program web page on the district website</u>
- 5. **Ensure your child(ren)'s vaccination/immunization records are up-to-date**. This particularly important if your child will be in 7th grade this year, as there were some updates your child needs to have before attending school. Note that these immunizations DO NOT include the COVID-19 vaccination. For more details, visit the <u>School Health Services web page</u>.
