Digital Devices ARE allowed with permission by Campus Administration & for instructional purposes ONLY. (Device Sign MUST be posted by teacher.)

NOTE: If we can hear your device it's too loud.

Digital Devices must be powered off and out of sight in backpacks/purses or lockers upon arrival to campus. It is not permissible for Digital Devices to be on "silent" or vibrate" during this time.

- ◆ Using devices to send/receive calls/text from family or friends during the instructional day. (You may request permission to call parents from the office ONLY)
- ◆ Using devices to record or take photos of staff or students without permission.
- ◆ Using devices to access social media.
- ◆ Using devices in the hallways, restrooms, locker room, and cafeteria.

ADVICE FOR YOUR DEVICE:

Be RESPONSIBLE for what you say, so that you can keep the grief away.

Don't forget and leave it all alone or you may quickly lose your phone.

Keep it close and put away, so that you don't miss out on your day.

Be GOOD, be BRIGHT, be OUT OF SIGHT! Don't snap, don't post, don't waste your time.
