We're sending this message to remind you of some actions to take to ensure that students with disabilities receive the accommodations they need when they take their new digital PSAT-related assessments in the fall. Parents must sign the consent form and return to the SSD Coordinator, Mr. Casely Hayford. [Parent Consent Form For Accommodations](#)

Accommodations on the PSAT™ 8/9 must be approved by College Board using the same process as for all other College Board assessments. Usually, the SSD coordinator will make the request through [SSD Online](#); however, a student and their parent/guardian can also request accommodations directly. Remember, accommodations on the digital PSAT/NMSQT and PSAT 8/9 may be different from accommodations on the paper and pencil test. To learn more, visit [Digital Testing With Accommodations](#)

All digital PSAT-related assessments are fully accessible, and most approved assistive technology will work during the test. For more information about how accommodations will be provided for the digital PSAT/NMSQT and PSAT 8/9, please visit our [Assistive Technology](#) webpage.

Encourage students to practice taking the PSAT-related assessments with their chosen assistive technologies or devices. PSAT/NMSQT practice tests will be available in the Bluebook™ digital testing app at the end of June, and PSAT 8/9 practice tests will be available at the end of August. Students should plan to devote some time to becoming familiar and comfortable with taking the test with their approved assistive technologies.
