Guys' dress code

- Formal dress
 - Tuxedos and suits acceptable
 - Ties encouraged but not required
 - Jackets encouraged but not required
 - If you don't wear a tuxedo or suit, plan to wear dress pants or slacks
 - Starched cowboy jeans are acceptable
 - No shorts allowed
- Pants must be worn at the waist
 - No sagging
 - No undergarments showing
- No torn clothing or anything that violates the FBISD dress code (clothing depicting drugs, weapons or nudity)

Girls' dress code

- Formal dress
- Length: dress hem or slit may not be shorter than mid-thigh when arms are raised
- Neckline: front of dress should not dip lower than cleavage
 - Cleavage should not be visible. A mesh panel may be sewn into cleavage to make dress appropriate
- Back: Open-backed dresses may not dip lower than natural waist
- Midriff: A maximum exposure of two inches will be allowed
 - Belly buttons should not be exposed
