Morning Arrival

All students are expected to be on campus no later than 8:45.

Please do not drop off your child earlier than 8:20 unless arrangements were made with a teacher to greet them at the front door for a meeting or tutorials.

Students enter the building in the morning by 8:20 am.





Morning Expectations

Arrival:

 $\Box 6^{th}$ grade: Report to boys' gym and sit in rows by teacher.

□7th grade: Report to girls' gym

 $\square 8^{th}$ grade: Report to the cafeteria

Breakfast:

All students are expected to:

Eat breakfast in the designated area in the cafeteria.
Finish eating in a timely manner and clean their area.
Go to the boys' gym once they are finished eating.

Afternoon Dismissal:

Where students will exit the building in the afternoon:

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□ Car riders will exit using the front doors. For safety reasons, no parking lot pick up or drop off. Students will not be allowed to walk to the parking lot, library, or any other location near the school.

□ Walkers will exit through the doors nearest the AP office. Again, no car pick up or drop off at this exit location.

 \Box Bus riders will exit out through the cafeteria to the bus ramp.



 \Box All students must be picked up by 5:00 pm.



Afternoon Dismissal

Last chance to check out your car rider for the day is at 3:25 pm.

□After 3:25 pm, we will begin a staggered dismissal at 4:10 pm.

All car riders, walkers and bus riders will be dismissed by hallways.

If a bus had not yet arrived, the students will report to the gym to be held until the bus arrives. Counselors and other personnel will be in the gym to supervise.

Skyward Family Access – Report Cards and Progress Reports

Step 1 - Log in to Family Access at - <u>http://www.fortbendisd.com/family-access</u>. Once you are at the Skyward Family Access webpage, click on "Login to Family Access" below where it says "Skyward Family Access".

Step 2 - Enter your login information and password *** If you do not know your information, please do one of the following:

1.Click forgot Username/Password, or

2.Contact Rana Taylor at (281) 634-5784 or email her at <u>rana.taylor@fortbendisd.com</u> **Step 3** – Click on "Portfolio" – located on the left side of the screen. (If using a mobile device, click on the "+" sign then click on "Portfolio").

Step 4 – A list of documents or reports will appear, click on the link with the title of the report (i.e. Progress Report 1).

Step 5 – The report will be generated. You will also have access to other reports about your child or your other children.

- Students will use their IDs to scan in, for lunch lines, for library, to purchase tickets, and other privileges.







