EQUIPP Fort Bend ISD 1:1 Initiative

- Laptops have been checked out to all enrolled students.
- Students are responsible for the care of their laptops and are to carry them to/from home on nights, weekends, breaks and summer.
- Encourage parents to purchase insurance for \$35/annually.
- If your child is having trouble connecting, the first effort should be to restart the computer.
- If restarting does not resolve issues, have your student put in an IT Support Ticket at the Support Portal in 1Link.
- We do have day check-out computers if your child forgets their computer. We will record the number of times this occurs and communicate with parents if a pattern develops.




Student IDs

- Students and staff are required to wear their IDs daily for safety.
- They are to be worn above the waist and where the photo is visible.
- IDs are being used in Nutrition, the Library and on buses.
- When the district moves into Phase 2 with the Ridership badges, parents will be able to load an app and track where your children are located while on the bus.
- If your student loses their ID, the replacement cost is \$5, which must be paid in RevTrak.
- If a student has a pattern of not wearing/not having their ID, their will be consequences in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct.



Meals at School

- Students may purchase breakfast or lunch in the Cafeteria.
 - Breakfast is served from 8:20 to 8:45 a.m.
 - Class starts at 8:50 a.m.
 - Lunch is served through A, B and C Lunch Shifts.
- Students may bring their breakfast/lunch to school.
- We do not accept deliveries of 3rd party meals to school.
- We do have microwaves available to students, donated by the QVMS PTO.



Student/Parent Transportation

- Student pick-up and drop-off should occur in the front drive. Obey the traffic signage to protect safety.
 - Please do not have children walk to vehicles in the neighborhood.
- Students are to be dropped off at curb closest to the front of the campus.
- Buses drop off at the bus ramp lane.
- Faculty/Staff traffic goes into the parking lot.
- Students should be dropped off no earlier than 8:00 a.m. and should be picked up after school by no later than 4:45 p.m., unless in a supervised activity at school.





Safety of Children

- All faculty/staff serving children in FBISD and QVMS have a thorough background check when hired, including fingerprinting and national clearinghouse searches.
- All faculty/staff receive annual training on safety requirements and practices.
- All faculty/staff are contractually responsible for abiding by the Texas Educator Code of Ethics.
- All educators are obligated reporters of possible child abuse or neglect. Reports must be made to Child Protective Services or law enforcement officers.
- We encourage all faculty/staff, parents, students and stakeholders to See Something, Say Something if there is a safety concern.

No Personal Technology Permitted

- Students are not permitted to have any personal technology out during the school day.
- All technology must be turned off/silent and put away, so as to avoid disruption of the learning day.
- Violations of the personal technology expectations result in Student Code of Conduct violations.



Lockers

- Students may now submit requests for lockers through the link in the Library Schoology course.
- Students are required to have parent permission to get a locker, read the Locker Expectations document, complete the form and watch a video about locker use before submitting a request to have a locker.
- It is a student responsiblity to secure the locker and to not share the combination.
- Lockers are a privilege and the privilege may be removed if issues develop with the use of lockers.
- QVMS and FBISD are not responsible for the contents placed in lockers.
