WORLD LANGUAGE:

____FL112 Spanish I *

(1 High School Credit – Regular Level)

If you take Spanish I in 8th grade, you should plan to **take Spanish II during your 9th grade year.**

You must earn TWO full credits in the same world language to meet your high school graduation requirements.

So, if you don't take Spanish in 8th grade it's okay. You have time in high school.



Tips to consider for Spanish:

- The student should have a good understanding and grasp of the English language, including grammar and vocabulary.
- The student should have strong reading and writing skills and be able to memorize and master concepts of the language, not just colors, numbers, etc.
- The student needs to be prepared to work hard, both in the classroom and at home. Learning a foreign language requires consistent studying at home on a daily basis
- The student should expect to have homework often, perhaps every day, and lots of quizzes and tests, both written and oral.
- The student should have good organizational skills in order to keep up with assignments and the pace of the course.
- The student should understand that this is a high school academic course that will be recorded on their high school transcript for grade points.
