- **Who:** opportunities exist for current 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students (specific programs/courses have specific grade requirements)
- **What:** Application
- **When:** OPENS Tuesday, January 21<sup>st</sup> at 8:00 AM and CLOSES Friday, February 21<sup>st</sup> at 10:00 PM
- **Where:** Reese Center website ([www.fortbendisd.com/jrctc](http://www.fortbendisd.com/jrctc)), CTE website (<https://www.fortbendisd.com/Domain/16416>)
- **How:** Student will use his/her FBISD username and password to log into the application. He/she can select up to 2 programs/pathways of interest to apply. He/she will answer 5 questions per program/pathway based on a Likert scale and submit.

Acceptance will begin after the application closes (2/21/2020). Acceptances will be sent to emails provided within the application process. Acceptances are based upon students' academic progress, attendance, and discipline records in Skyward, and program interest, as measured by Likert scale questions.
