Size Standards Tool



Do you qualify as a small business for government contracting purposes?

START

Size standards vary by industry and are generally based on **the number of employees or the amount of annual revenues the business has.**

- Manufacturing or processing firm with 1,500 employees (refinery, aircraft, oil transportation, airline, delivery service).
- Service firm up to \$47M (oil/gas support, software publishing, radio/TV broadcasting, car rental, trash collection).



WHAT QUALIFIES A FIRM AS A SMALL BUSINESS?

- ❑ **The owner's Personal Net Worth can not exceed \$2.047 Million Dollars**

*Anyone that owns at least 5% or more of the company

- ❑ **The owner's gross receipts must comply with SBA's Table of Industry Size Standards**

*A size standard, which is usually stated in number of employees or average annual receipts, represents the largest size that a business may be to remain classified as a small business for SBA and federal contracting programs.

- ❑ **(NAICS Codes)** North American Industry Classification System

*These are usually a 6-digit number to **classify your business** based on the primary type of work the business performs

NEW APPLICANTS
BASIC REQUIRED DOCUMENTS
(30 days)

- **Firm must be in operation for a minimum of 1 year and have at least \$5,000 dollars in revenue**
- **Each Owner's Personal Net Worth Statement**
- **Signed and Notarized Affidavit**
- **Firm's Federal Income Tax Return for the last 3 years, along with all Schedule pages**
- **Owner's Federal Income Tax Return for 1 Year**
-If the firm does not have 3 years of company taxes, we ask for 2 years of personal taxes (If firm has been in business for only 1 year).
- **2 invoices and proof of payment are accepted to show proof of revenue**
- **3 work references**
- **Copy of the Certificate of formation (Articles to your company)**



Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Does METRO accept SBE certifications from the City of Houston on contracts?

A: No, METRO only accepts DBE certifications from the City of Houston. Metro offers reciprocity to DBE firms with any entity. You will need your DBE letter or certificate with the assigned NAICS codes.

Q: Does METRO accept MBE, WBE, or HUB certifications from other agencies?

A: METRO only accepts DBE as reciprocity from other agencies.

Q: Do I need to submit my SBE certificate to Prime Contractors to show proof of my certification?

A: Yes, you can submit your SBE certificate or SBE letter to Prime Contractors to show proof of certification.

Q: Will METRO send a reminder to renew my certification after 3 years?

A: Yes, the OEBO department and the B2GNOW system will send you a reminder to renew certification.

Q: Do I need to be SBE certified to do work with Metro?

A: No, you do not have to be SBE certified to do business with Metro. If you feel your company has the capacity to prime a contract, go for it! But keep in mind you do have to be Metro certified in order to meet any goals we have placed on the contracts that are \$50k and up.
