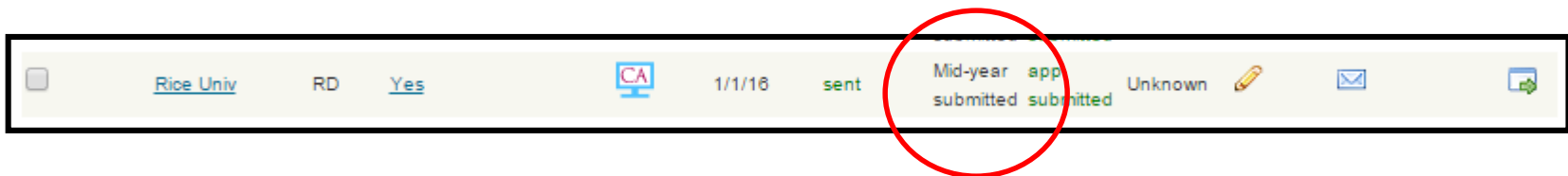
- Deadline to fill out survey is **Friday, February 2nd**.

Mid-Year Reports

 - They won't know to complete one for you **without an e-mail request**.
 - The Mid-Year Report includes a Mid-Year Transcript
