

AHS/HCC Dual Credit Registration Steps



- **1.** Make sure you requested the correct dual credit courses in SchooLinks by February 14, 2025.
- 2. Submit HCC Application Through ApplyTexas
 - If you have already taken dual credit through HCC previously and have an HCC ID, you do NOT need to apply again and can skip this step.
 - Apply Using: www.applytexas.org
 - Use your first and last name as they are listed in Skyward, not the name you go by casually.
 - Only fill out the required fields marked with the red asterisk(*).
 - o Type of Application: Dual Credit
 - Program Plan: Scroll to Liberal Arts and Humanities→choose Associate of Arts in Multidisciplinary Studies
 - Term: Choose the one in which you will begin dual credit → Summer 2025, Fall 2025, or Spring 2026
 - You only submit **ONE** HCC application even if you are taking courses in multiple terms.
 - o If you do not have a SS#, HCC will assign a P number to you.
 - Within 2-3 days, you will receive an acceptance email from HCC with an HCC ID # (Starts with a W with 9 digits after it). Do not lose this #.
 - You cannot complete the next steps until you receive the HCC ID number.

3. Complete and Submit Required Paperwork

- Submit the following forms to Mrs. Richter in H1
 - o FBISD Credit Course Request
 - 0 HCC Dual Credit Waiver Approval Form
- You cannot turn in these forms without an HCC ID#.

Application and paperwork due dates: For SUMMER: February 12, 2025 For FALL/SPRING: March 26, 2025

Failure to complete all necessary steps above will result in ineligibility to take DC courses, and student's schedule will be changed to a non-dual credit class.
