What is the TSIA2?

The TSI Assessment 2 (TSIA2) is an assessment that determines if you are ready for college-level course work in the general areas of reading, writing, and mathematics. This program also will help determine what type of course or intervention will best meet your needs to help you prepare for college-level course work if you are not ready.

What do the scores mean? Tests are divided into sections. The first section on both ELAR and Math is the College Readiness Classification (CRC), which is multiple choice. Students who do not score highly enough on the CRC will be given the Diagnostic section, which is a second opportunity to pass the test. ELAR testers will also take the WritePlacer essay.

- 2. Click "Information for Students", then "Your ACCUPLACER or TSIA2 Score Report"
- 3. Your Student ID will be your TSDS ID # (at the top of this sheet). The Student Institution is Fort Bend ISD.
- 4. You will be emailed a link to view and print your results. If you did not change your email as instructed, you will not receive your results as Accuplacer will not send to a FBISD student email. See Mrs. J to change your email address
