Our partners are recognized as leaders in Fort Bend County through their involvement with FBISD and the value that they place on quality education. Working together with FBISD, businesses are able to help prepare our students for a future beyond what they can imagine.

Following are only a few examples of FBISD's exceptional partnerships in action:

The **Sugar Land Rotary** donated \$30,000 to the Literacy Council of Fort Bend to fund a GED project at Fort Bend ISD's Ridgemont Early Childhood Center. The donation will help fund the project for the next five years. The Literacy Council has been in partnership with FBISD for the past three years. The organization began providing GED preparation classes at Ridgemont in September 2014. Currently, 15 adults take part in the evening classes that focus on the math, English Language Arts and civics portions of the test. The Sugar Land Rotary donation will fund five years of teacher compensation (at \$5,000 per year) and scholarship awards (\$1,000 per year for five years).

Briargate Elementary School students are benefiting from a health program funded by the CPA's Helping School Committee of the Houston CPA Society. Patrina Baker, a Physical Education teacher received a \$1,500 grant from CPA to fund the purchase of GeoMotion mats for the "Building Better Minds and Bodies at Briargate" program she developed. The program benefits all 577 students, as well as teachers at the school.



Hunters Glen Elementary School students received a generous gift of backpacks filled with school supplies thanks to a timely donation from Fluor employees. As part of their annual backpack project, Fluor employees collected grade appropriate school supplies (such as notebook paper, composition books, pencils, pens, crayons, scissors and other supplies) and backpacks to assist Hunters Glen Elementary families with their backto-school needs. 

#### How does our garden grow?... with support from enthusiastic business partners!

This year, the American Heart Association and the **Ridgemont Early Childhood Center** formed a budding new partnership to create an edible teaching garden on the campus grounds that will give students access to fresh fruits and vegetables, while teaching them the importance of healthy eating. AHA volunteers joined employees from **Reliant Energy** and **RMECC staff** this summer in constructing the garden.

The adult volunteers spent the day building garden bed boxes, loading soil into wheelbarrows and planting vegetable seedlings in time for the new school year. The AHA donated all the materials and supplies, including pallets of wood, an irrigation system, shovels, gloves, pruning shears, water hoses, buckets, as well as seeds and plants. The association also donated a digital camera for RMECC staff to document activity and progress made in the garden. AHA staff has made a two-year commitment to the school to help students maintain the garden.

#### **Spotlight:** WatchDOGS

#### My Provider, My Protector, My Hero - My Dad

A father is a child's first male role model who exemplifies courage and strength, while demonstrating moral values. Fathers, and other adult, male family members, play an important part in students' lives, especially when they make their presence felt at school through such programs as WatchDOGS (Dads of Great Students), the male mentoring group.

WatchDOGS is an innovative father involvement, educational initiative of the National Center for Fathering. FBISD is proud to offer the Shared Dreams Program. This distinctive program relies on monetary and in-kind donations from campuses, and business and community partners. #### Science Safety Success! – Sienna Crossing Elementary

If you attach the rate of \$23.40, a rate etablished by the Independent Sector for all the services rendered, more than \$8.4 million dollars in volunteer services were donated to our district this year.
