Overview of the Cheerleader/Mascot Discipline Policy Cumulative 20 point demerit system

- 1. Demerit Record
 - Record will be established for all cheerleaders/mascots.
 - The record will record all infractions for the entire school year
 - Demerits cannot be worked off
 - The record will be maintained solely by the sponsor/cheer coach and be kept confidential.
 - When a demerit is recorded on the record, the sponsor and the cheerleader/mascot will both initial.
 - When a cheerleader/mascot receives a cumulative of 5-7 demerits, the sponsor will be required to personally counsel with the cheerleader/mascot and his/her parent/guardian.
- 2. 10 Cumulative Demerits = Probation
 - When a cheerleader reaches a cumulative of 10 demerits, the cheerleader/mascot would be placed on probation for a 9 week period.
 - The probation will be documented in writing by sponsor and signed by campus administrator. Probation statement will be mailed to parent/guardian.
- 3. 20 Cumulative Demerits = Dismissal from squad
 - If a cheerleader/mascot accumulates 20 demerits, the cheerleader will be dismissed from the cheer team. A written notice and copy of the demerit record will be prepared by the sponsor/coach, and signed by both the sponsor/coach and campus administrator. A copy of this statement will be mailed to the student's parent/guardian, with a copy to the district athletic director. Any student dismissed will be ineligible for future tryouts.
- 4. Resignation
 - If a cheerleader/mascot resigns from the squad, he/she will be ineligible for future tryouts.
- 5. Additional Discipline
 - In addition to demerits issued for infractions, the sponsor/coach may also give additional discipline, such as running laps, running steps, additional sign making, as deemed necessary.
