## CIS PROVIDES:

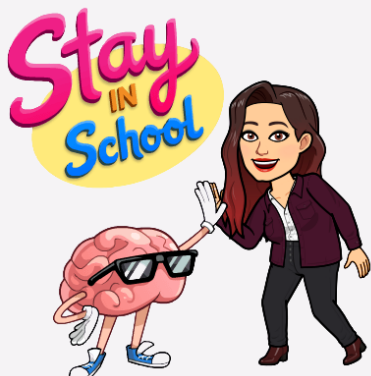
- A trusted person to talk to
