A MOMENT IN TIME CHALLENGE

Building a time capsule is a fun activity and a great way to preserve memories. A time capsule is a container that holds objects to show today's culture and generally centers around a specific event or moment in time. Families of gifted students (1-12) will build a time capsule to capture special memories from the year 2020.

MATERIALS

Plastic Container or Shoe Box Items Found at Home

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Find at least 5 items you want to include in your time capsule. Remember your time capsule should be personalized and fun! The following is a list of items you may choose to consider (you are not limited to these items, be creative):
- An item that represents something you enjoy doing for fun
- An item that is popular (movie, books, music)
- An item that you cherish
- An item that represents your family or culture
- An item that documents daily life such as a "to do" list, schedule, receipt, journal entry
- Choose a container. In order to make your time capsule, choose a container to store your items. Choosing your
 container depends on how long you plan to keep it hidden.
- 3. Determine where you will store your time capsule. You will need to decide if you will store your time capsule indoors or outdoors when choosing your container. You should also consider gathering your items first before selecting the container. You want to be sure you will have enough space for your items.
- 4. Decorate your time capsule. After adding your items, get creative and decorate your container. Remember your time capsule should be fun and represent you!
