- Acceleration is working on proposed professional development related to the acceleration program

- Communication is updating the monthly newsletter to improve it going forward- some revamps started in the last month or two.

- Elementary Service Expansion is in early phases of research on which programs may be feasible to use in FBISD.

- Representation is reviewing enrollment data to determine where we have problems and then will move to how to start addressing them.

- Student Identification and Expansion reviewed how we are currently identifying and compared it to the Texas State plan and other districts. They are determining how to best alter our current process.
