September 15, 2021 General Meeting of the GT PAC

Hosted by Wendy Pennings, President of the PAC

- Wendy opens the meeting and indicates the attendance link for everyone to register their attendance. She acknowledges that we know some people are unable to attend due to ongoing issues with power post hurricane.
- Wendy introduces the executive board and attendees from the GT department. Sharon and Kim both say hello and explain which campus they represent. Dr. Westphal and Ms. Coleman-Holmes also say hello. Wendy explains that Cathy Hunter will represent the GT Task Force and will provide updates monthly.
- Everyone is encouraged to review the powerpoint from last month if anyone missed the meeting.
- Wendy reviews general information about what the PAC is, who is on it, and the goals of the PAC.
- Wendy explains the requirements for membership on the PAC, including regular attendance, serving on a subcommittee, and availability to be a liaison to the campus you represent.
- Wendy shows the GT PAC homepage on the district website, so everyone can see our email, a calendar of meetings, past meetings, etc.
- Dr. Westphal's monthly update:

- GT Task Force Update with Cathy Hunter
 - Task Force has not met yet this year.
- Cathy explains who is on the Task Force, and the current subcommittees that meet to work on the District's 5 year plan to improve the GT programming. Dr. Westphal links to the 5 year plan for people to reference.
- GT PAC updates
- President Elect had to resign because of a move out of district. We will have an upcoming election to replace that role. Wendy covers the requirements for that position. We have a few people running for the position, but if anyone else is interested, please reach out to Aisha Coleman-Holmes to be added to the ballot.
- Subcommittee ideas were generated by the Executive Board, so we are putting our ideas out there and encourage the group to add to those ideas. The parent symposium will be one of the four subcommittees. The other three will be selected by the group. Executive Board ideas were 1) increasing GT PAC participation to make sure every campus has representation, and

encourage GT PAC representatives to be connected and available to their campuses; 2) Social and Emotional Support for Secondary Students; 3) GT PAC Parent Mentorship for new families coming into the program; 4) Resources for Parents and Family Series. We will rank these four, but also can add additional ideas if people have them.
