#### Goal 1: FBISD will provide an educational system that will enable all students to reach their full potential.

**Performance Objective 1:** The percentage of FHCL students scoring proficient or higher in math problem solving will increase by 15% at the end of the student's change of placement as measured by a local pre/post math CFA administered during the student's first instructional day and again approximately 2 weeks prior to exit.

**Performance Objective 2:** 100% of FHCL students will produce a writing sample reflecting on the circumstances that led to a change of placement and lessons learned during the change of placement as part of the student's exit requirements. The student's writing sample will be assessed based on the STAAR rubric with scores documented and shared with the student's home campus via the assigned home campus administrator.

**Performance Objective 3:** Goal 3: 100% of students graduating within the 2014-2015 school year scheduled for courses not offered by FHCL/JJAEP will be provided a contractual agreement allowing the student to complete coursework provided by the home campus teacher and facilitated by an assigned FHCL/JJAEP teacher who is not highly qualified to teach the course. This temporary agreement during change of placement will establish the FHCL/JJAEP teacher as the teacher of record but assignments, instruction and grading are completed by the home campus teacher if agreed upon by the administration and teacher of the home campus.

**Performance Objective 4:** Goal 4: FHCL/JJAEP will increase the use of instructional strategies including technology implementation by 50% in the classroom through professional development and by utilizing interactive activities/lessons/demonstrations, modeling and promoting student-created products with the use of iPads and other technology motivated strategies.

### Goal 2: FBISD will recruit, develop, and retain effective teachers and staff.

**Performance Objective 1:** FHCL administration will work to increase campus climate morale by 10% this academic school year in order to maintain staff and alleviate turnover.

### Goal 3: FBISD will provide a supportive climate and a safe learning /working environment.

**Performance Objective 1:** FHCL/JJAEP will work 100% throughout the school year to support staff and students within the campus framework of structure by implementing and maintaining the authenticity of Nonviolent Crisis Intervention (CPI) training, CHAMPS, and Foundations in an effort to reduce behavioral issues that would lead to student removal from classes into ISS, OSS, DAEP, DEP, and JJAEP, particularly supporting the needs, modification, and accommodations of At-Risk and Special Education students.

### Goal 4: FBISD will provide and promote leadership development at all levels.

**Performance Objective 1:** FHCL/JJAEP administration will consciously recruit, mentor, and coach campus personnel and provide them with leadership roles to assist in the development of potential leaders at all levels, 50% of the academic school year.

### Goal 5: FBISD will be a collaborative, efficient, and effective learning community.

**Performance Objective 1:** FHCL/JJAEP will increase the scheduled meeting times of the professional learning communities established by departments by 25% this academic school year in order to increase the professional growth and development of teachers within their disciplines and establish a collaborative, efficient, and effective learning community.

**Performance Objective 2:** 100% of students approved to attend FHCL/JJAEP will attend orientation with their parent/legal guardian listed in Skyward in order to communicate the alternative campus guidelines and expectations.
