



2024 SUMMER O-LAB Frequently Asked Questions

1. Where will my student attend Summer O-LAB?
Students will attend Summer O-LAB at the campus they will attend the following school year. Some campuses may hold their Summer O-LAB at a different campus due to construction.
2. Is the program synchronous or asynchronous?
The program is asynchronous. However, quizzes, tests, and cumulative exams must be taken on campus. It may be beneficial to report to campus daily to ensure ongoing progress.
3. What session will my child be enrolled in?
There are no sessions in Summer O-LAB. It is one long session. Students have the entire session to complete their course(s). The 23-24 Summer O-LAB session is June 10th – July 24th.
4. How many courses can students take?
Students can take two courses offered by Summer O-LAB. Each course is .5 credits. District policy states students are allowed to earn 1.0 credits during summer learning.
5. Do students have to attend Summer O lab orientation?
Yes, Summer O-LAB orientation is MANDATORY (see campus O-LAB flyer for location and dates).
6. How long is orientation? Orientation is between 30 to 60 minutes long.
7. Can parents attend orientations? Orientation is for students only.
8. What happens if a student cannot attend orientation during one of the scheduled times?
Students must notify the O-LAB teacher and arrange an alternative orientation.
9. When do registration and payment for courses close?
Registration opens March 18th and closes May 2nd. All payments must be made by May 7th.
10. When does Summer O-lab begin? All Summer O-LAB classes start June 10th.
11. What are the campus Summer O-lab hours?
Each campus' Summer O-lab hours are different. This information will be provided during orientation.
12. How will a student/parent know when their student is enrolled in the course?
The parent will receive a notification email about orientation on or about mid-May if they have paid for the course. Once the student begins the course, the parent will receive daily/weekly emails containing a student progress report.
13. What happens if a parent/student does not receive a course enrollment notification?
If the parent/student does not receive correspondence by May 15th, they should contact the campus O-Lab immediately. DO NOT wait until June 12.
14. What happens if I register for a course but do not pay by May 7th?
The student will automatically be dropped from the course if the fee is not paid by 11:59 pm on April 15th.
15. When is the last day to request a refund? The last day to request a refund is June 12th.
16. When can students take their cumulative (final) exam?
Students can take the final exam upon completing the coursework. They do not have to wait until July 27.
17. Does the cumulative (final) exam have to be proctored?
Yes, the cumulative (final) exam must be taken onsite during open lab hours. The last date to take it is July 24th at noon. The student must arrive no later than 10:00 am.
