GOAL 1: Each campus administrator shall create a campus-based school health advisory council (Campus Wellness Committee) to coordinate health and wellness initiatives in compliance with this policy.

Objective 1: The campus administrator will annually invite parents, staff, administrators, students, school nurses, child nutrition employees, and community members to be members of the wellness committee.

Action Steps

The campus principal will inform the staff, students, parents and community of the existence and purpose of the School Wellness Committee.

- The campus principal will encourage staff, students, school nurses, parents and community members to be members of the Campus Wellness Committee during campus and community events such as PTA meetings, health and wellness fairs, community events and open house.
- The Campus Wellness Committee will meet at least four times per year.

Objective 2: The District will provide the tools and resources including the Wellness Policy, Wellness Regulations, and Wellness Plan to the Campus Wellness Committee to define their purpose and goals for the school year.

Action Steps

The District will provide campus administrators a Wellness Handbook, the Wellness Plan FFA (LOCA), the Pre-Campus Wellness Survey and the Annual Campus Wellness Committee Report.

- The District will require all campuses to complete a Pre-Campus Wellness Survey. The survey will help the Campus Wellness Committee to preassess compliance with Wellness Plan goals.
- The District will require the Campus Improvement Plan (CIP) to include at least one Health and Wellness goal as identified by the Pre-Campus Wellness Survey.
- The District will require each campus to submit an Annual Campus Wellness Committee Report at the end of the
