"Summer slide is the loss of academic skills over summer vacation". Additionally, she indicates one reason for the loss of skills is the lack of access to books. During the school year, students can check out books to take home weekly. However, during the summer, access to books diminishes since school libraries are closed. However, if you have a public library card, students can download and read eBooks for free. All that is needed is a portable device or tablet with the Hoopla, Libby or Overdrive apps. Finally, other ways that students can maintain or improve their reading skills is to read a favorite magazine, recipe books, the Sunday comics, or the sports section of the newspaper.
