Fort Bend ISD presents a new and exciting educational program to help meet the needs of early childhood learners. The Early Intervention Academy, housed at Ridgemont Elementary's Early Childhood Center, opens for the 2018–19 school year. For its inaugural year, the academy will serve FBISD students who are three (3) years old on or before September 1; and who are identified with Autism, Non-Categorical Early Childhood for suspected Autism or Intellectual Disability.

Academy highlights

- Full day preschool program from 8:10 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.
- Extended school year with 199 instructional days
- Additional therapy services in occupational, speech and music therapy
- Applied Behavior Analysis intervention up to 20 hours per week
- Structured, explicit social skills delivery model to engage children in the intervention
- Family outreach, training and coaching
- Ongoing program evaluation and progress monitoring
