SAFETY GUIDANCE

Please be assured that FBISD is closely monitoring all local and state health official guidance, and is following current TEA and CDC guidance regarding school openings. For the safety of all participants, all staff and students will be screened prior to the start of services, through temperature checks and questionnaires. In addition to these screenings, the following practices will be in place:

1. We are limiting each classroom to no more than 11 people in the classroom. This includes staff and students
2. We will limit exposure to others outside your student's classroom and minimize interactions as much as possible, and common areas will be sanitized frequently.
3. All snacks/meals will be consumed in the classroom, and students are encouraged to bring their own water bottle to limit fountain usage
4. Personal Protective Equipment, or PPE, will be provided to all staff in the form of masks and gloves. Additional PPE will be provided as needed
5. Students are encouraged to wear face coverings, but we recognize coverings may not be tolerated by all students. Masks will be provided to students who need them
6. No visitors will be permitted in the building
7. No large group activities or gatherings will be permitted.
8. Anyone with a temperature over 100.0° F will not be allowed onto the bus/into the building and MUST have a physician letter for return

Special Education Transportation precautions include:

1. Social distancing with a student placed in every other seat of the bus
2. Students will load the bus starting at the back and moving to the front so that students do not directly pass each other
3. All buses will be wiped down between routes

We understand the apprehension you may feel in sending your child to a campus at this time. All parents will be contacted prior to the start of the services, by their ESY teacher, to discuss. Thank you for the opportunity to work with you and your child this summer.
